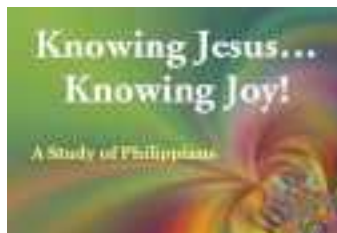

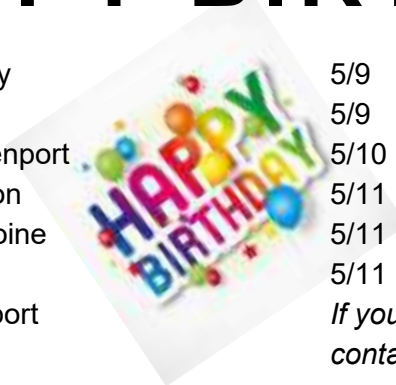

- empty plastic water bottles



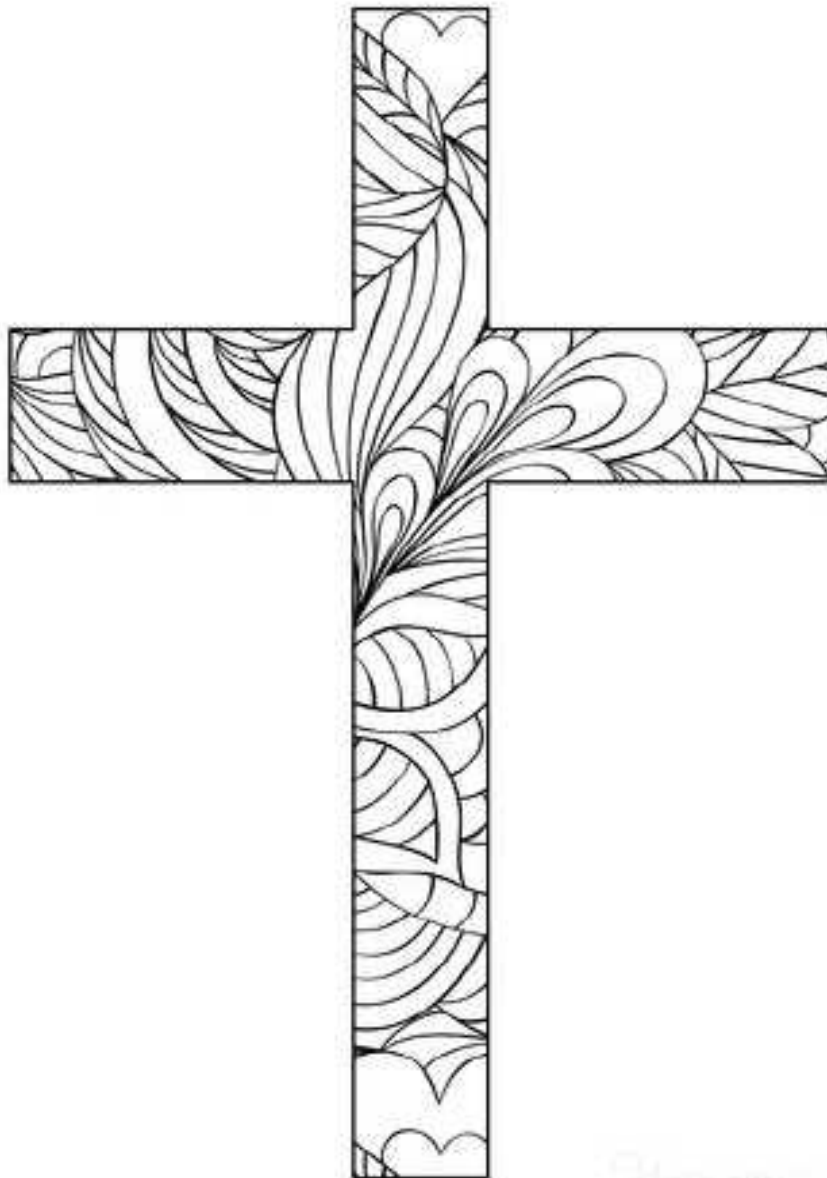
